GABRIEL (ARCHANGEL) LK 1:7-26 DA. 8:16

before the LORD my God for the holy mountain of my God,  
 21 yes, while I was speaking in prayer, the man <sup>a</sup>Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the beginning, being caused to <sup>1</sup>fly swiftly, reached me about the time of the evening offering.  
 22 And he informed me, and talked with me, and said, "O Daniel, I have now come forth to give you skill to understand."  
 23 "At the beginning of your supplications the <sup>1</sup>command went out, and I have come to tell you, for you are greatly <sup>a</sup>beloved; therefore <sup>b</sup>consider the matter, and understand the vision:

24 "Seventy <sup>1</sup>weeks are determined For your people <sup>2</sup>and for your holy city, - JERUSALEM  
 To finish the transgression, <sup>3</sup>  
 To make an end of sins, <sup>4</sup>  
 To make reconciliation for iniquity, <sup>5</sup>  
 To bring in everlasting righteousness, <sup>6</sup>  
 To seal up vision and prophecy, <sup>7</sup>  
 And to anoint <sup>2</sup>the Most Holy. <sup>8</sup>

25 "Know therefore and understand, That (from) the going forth of the command To restore and build Jerusalem (Until) <sup>a</sup>Messiah <sup>b</sup>the Prince, <sup>4</sup> There shall be seven weeks <sup>2</sup> and sixty-two weeks; <sup>3</sup> The <sup>1</sup>street shall be built again, and the <sup>2</sup>wall, Even in troublesome times. <sup>2</sup>

26 "And after the sixty-two weeks <sup>1</sup> Messiah shall <sup>1</sup>be cut off, <sup>5</sup> but not for Himself; <sup>2</sup> And <sup>c</sup>the people of the prince who is to come - <sup>3</sup>To A.D. JERUSALEM Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. <sup>6</sup> The end of it shall be with a flood. - MILITARY ARMY (REV. 17:15 - ISA. 59:19) And till the end of the war desolations are determined. <sup>6</sup>

Vision of the Glorious Man (454 B.C.)

10 In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a message was revealed to Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar. The message was true, but the appointed time was long; and he understood the message, and had understanding of the vision.

2 In those days I, Daniel, was mourning three full weeks.  
 3 I ate no pleasant food, no meat or wine came into my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

4 Now on the twenty-fourth day of the first month, as I was by the side of the great river, that is, the Tigris, - HE ADVANCES FROM GABRIEL TO JESUS IN REVELATION.

5 I lifted my eyes and looked, and behold, a certain man clothed in linen, whose waist was girded with gold of Uphaz!

6 His body was like beryl, his face like the appearance of lightning, his eyes like torches of fire, his arms and feet like burnished bronze in color, and the sound of his words like the voice of a multitude.

7 And I, Daniel, alone saw the vision, for the men who were with me did not see the vision; but a great terror fell upon them, so that they fled to hide themselves. - REV. 6:16

8 Therefore I was left alone when I saw this great vision, and no strength remained in me; for my vigor was turned to frailty in me, and I retained no strength.

9 Yet I heard the sound of his words; and while I heard the sound of his words I was in a deep sleep on my face, with my face to the ground. PAINTED? COMP. 8:27

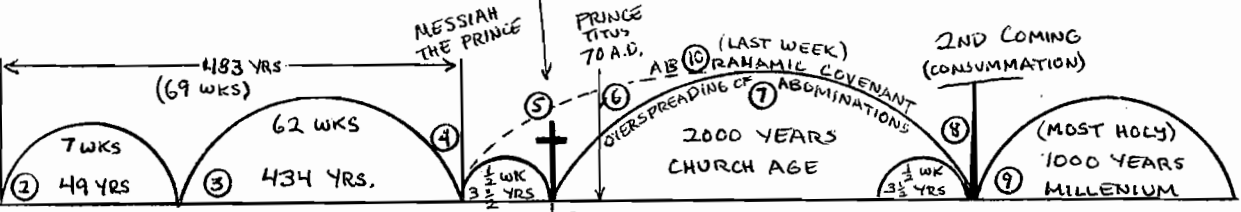
